Betty wins 3 American Specialties, 2 Canadian Specialties, & 1 National BOS Sweepstakes



Am/Can Ch Beowulf Betting On Cohutta started her show career winning her 1st point from the puppy class first time she was in the ring at 7 months. At 8 months Betty won Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes at the 2003 National Specialty under breeder-judge Jean Robinson and also won her 6 -9 puppy class.



From then on Betty was only shown at regional specialties and the 2005 National Specialty where she went 2nd in a huge open class. At 10 months Betty won BOW and AOM at the Delaware Valley Specialty under Judith Goodin. Betty then went Winners and won Award of Merits at two Southeast Bullmastiff Specialties under Betty Krause and Robert Vandiver to complete her championship.



In Canada Betty won 5 points at the 2004 Ontario Specialty and 4 points at the supported entry the same day. Betty returned to finish her championship at the 2005 Ontario Specialty for 5 more points.

Betty was co-bred with Chris Lezotte and Alan Kalter back her 5th generation grandsire, BIS Ch Leatherneck Bit of HappyLegs producing Beowulf Two Bit HappyLegs, Duece. Duece is owned by Chris and Alan and co-owned with their handler Norma Smith. Betty was bred by Sharon Garrett out of Ch Cohutta's Make No Mistake sired by my ZAK, Ch Beowulf Zackery of GraWel. Although Betty easily clears 24 inch jumps, she much prefers to be on the sofa with her dad, Nick Douglas.
